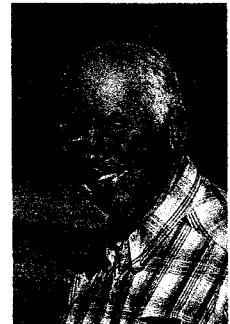

BY-LAW Revisions

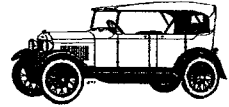
